### **Wearing of American Legion Emblem (Patches and Legion Caps)**

Only the American Legion Riders shoulder and back patch, as copyrighted and sold by The American Legion's Emblem Sales division or Nationally approved vender, is authorized for wear by all members in good standing of the ALR. Department standards for patches and rockers are on file with Emblem Sales. Shoulder and patches will be as follows: Shoulder patch (4"x5 ½ 3-Line and 4x 3 ½ 1-Line"); back patch (8. ½ "x12" 3-Line and 8 ½ "X10" 1-Line). The 3-Line patches will have two bottom lines and one top line. The first bottom line being the City (Example: Fruitland Park) and the second will be Chapter or Post (Example: Chapter 219) The single top line above "AMERICA" will indicate 'FLORIDA CHAPTER' (Example: FLORIDA CHAPTER). Also Gold stitching on the rim of the patch indicates Charter Members and gold stars on either side of the word "AMERICAN" indicate a life member. **Only lower Rockers** are allowed and they must be in gold letters and placed below the respective size patch, small rocker (3/4" x 3-3/4") and larger rocker (1-1/2" X 8= ½") accordingly. The words on the Rocker can only be: Legionnaire or Veteran, Auxiliary, and SAL or Squadron. Rockers are optional. Legion Riders belonging to an officially chartered Legion Rider Chapter are permitted to wear the Legion Rider vest to Department Convention, Fall Conference, District Meetings and Conferences. The official uniform of The American Legion is the Legion cap. This is to be worn at official American Legion functions and meetings.
